

Transport to and from matches and training:

Chichester Priory Park Cricket Club are following ECB Guidelines regarding transport to and from matches and training as outlined below:

- All parents/carers that parents/carers are responsible for the safe delivery and collection of their child for matches or training
- Fixture information can be found on our website cppcc.co.uk at the beginning of each season providing information for all planned away fixtures or competitions to provide parents/carers with an opportunity to make appropriate arrangements
- Coaches and club staff will be responsible for children in their care when on the club premises or on arrival at opponents' cricket grounds
- It is not the responsibility of the coach or team manager to transport, or arrange to transport, the children to and from the club or match
- The club will receive permission from parents/carers for children to participate in all competitions and away fixtures/events
- The parent/carer is responsible for "pick up and drop off" of their child/children for all matches and training. In the event of an emergency it is the responsibility of the parent/carer to contact the club representative to advise of delay. An authorised club representative will remain until collection is achieved so that no child will be left unaccompanied
